

Aircraft Marshaller Refresher

Course Aim

The course is designed to refresh, reinforce, and update participants' knowledge, skills, and professional attitudes required to regulate and coordinate the activities and movement of aircraft, vehicles, and personnel on the apron ensuring effective risk management during aircraft turnarounds and maintaining the highest levels of safety and efficiency in accordance with applicable national regulations, airport procedures and international aviation standards

Who should attend

- i. Aircraft Marshals
- ii. Ramp Personnel
- iii. Ground Handling Staff
- iv. Airside Operations Officers
- v. Airport Operations Personnel involved in aircraft parking and movement of aircraft
- vi. Supervisors responsible for apron safety and aircraft handling
- vii. Personnel whose marshalling certification requires recurrent training

Entry Requirements

- Holder of Successful Apron management Certificate OR
- Holder of successful ramp certificate, safety management system certificate, ground handling certificate and compliance certificate
