

## Dangerous Goods Regulations for Personnel Responsible for the Screening of Passengers and Crew and their Baggage, Cargo, And Mail-Initial

### Course Aim

The course is intended for aviation security personnel responsible for screening passengers, crew, baggage, cargo, and mail, including security screeners, screening supervisors, and other staff assigned aviation security screening duties.

- Ability to communicate effectively in English
