

ICAO Air Cargo and Mail Security Course

Course Aim

This course is designed to equip participants with knowledge, skills and attitude required to integrate knowledge of Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) into the context of their designated role in their organization as part of a national responsibility to secure air cargo and mail against acts of unlawful interference, in accordance with ICAO Annex 17 and the Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973 - Restricted) and National guidance materials.

Who should attend

Aviation Security (AVSEC) personnel responsible for the development, implementation and oversight of air cargo and mail security measures, to include:

- State civil aviation authority personnel responsible for aviation security; and
- Personnel from other regulatory authorities, airports, airlines, and/or other stakeholders that have an active role in maintaining Air Cargo and Mail security

Entry Requirements

Must be actively employed in an aviation, security, regulatory, law enforcement, or related role with responsibilities for aviation security, security oversight, risk management, or the implementation of security measures. Employer endorsement is required.

- iv. Screening of Air Cargo
- v. Chain of Custody
- vi. Oversight and Compliance
- vii. Security of Mail
