

ICAO Aviation Security (AVSEC) Managers Course

Course Aim

This course is designed to equip participants with knowledge, skills and attitude required to enable managerial-level aviation security personnel with the tools to plan, coordinate, and implement airport security preventive measures in accordance with ICAO Annex 17 and the Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973) (Restricted) and the state guidance materials.

Who should attend

- Participants should be at managerial or senior supervisor level, primarily responsible for the application of aviation security preventive measures at airports or
- other aviation security personnel aspiring to advance their career

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age: 18 years
- Must be actively employed in a role where aviation security duties are among the core functions, and the employer must provide formal confirmation of the same
- Ability to communicate effectively in English
- Holder of certificate of successful completion of ICAO Basic Aviation Security Course or experience in security related position
