

ICAO Basic Aviation Security Course

Course Aim

This course is designed to equip participants with knowledge, skills and attitude required to educate security personnel, and those responsible for the implementation of aviation security measures in order to enhance overall protection against acts of unlawful interference in accordance with ICAO Annex 17, ICAO Security Manual Doc 8973 (Restricted) and National guidance materials.

Who should attend

- New entrants and/or existing personnel at the operational level primarily responsible for the application of aviation security measures at airports; or
- Personnel from other aviation-related entities engaged in aviation security support activities.

Entry Requirements

Minimum age: 18 years

Must be actively employed in a role where aviation security duties are among the core functions, and the employer must provide formal confirmation of the same

Minimum of diploma recognized by NACTVET or Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education (ACSEE) OR;

For the case of non-Tanzanian certificate holders, submission of a nomination form or letter from ICAO, Civil Aviation Authority, Airport Authority, Aircraft Operator or Ground Handling Agent as applicable

Ability to communicate effectively in English
