This course is designed to equip participants with knowledge, skills and attitude required to screen persons, baggage, air cargo and mail, vehicles, inflight and airport supplies in accordance with ICAO Annex 17, ICAO Security Manual Doc 8973 (Restricted) and National guidance materials

Who should attend

Newly recruited aviation security screeners.

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age: 18 years
- Successful completion of ICAO Basic Aviation Security
- Must be actively employed in a role where aviation security duties are among the core functions, and the employer must provide formal confirmation of the same
- Ability to communicate effectively in English

- xii. Aircraft security search and checks
- xiii. Contrabands
- xiv. Practical Sessions
