

ICAO Aviation Security National Inspectors Course

Course Aim

This course is designed to equip participants with theoretical knowledge and practical skills of fundamental aspects to perform audits and inspections as part of a National Quality Control system in accordance with ICAO Annex 17 and the Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973) (Restricted) and National guidance materials.

Who should attend

National Aviation Security Inspectors, Supervisors, Instructors, Managers, Quality control/compliance personnel and other aviation security personnel aspiring to advance their career

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age: 18 years
- Must be actively employed in a role where aviation security duties are among the core functions, and the employer must provide formal confirmation of the same
- Minimum of diploma recognized by NACTVET or Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education (ACSEE) OR;
- For the case of non-Tanzanian certificate holders, submission of a nomination form or letter from ICAO, Civil Aviation Authority, Airport Authority, Aircraft Operator or Ground Handling Agent as applicable
- Holder of certificate of successful completion of ICAO Basic Aviation Security Course or experience in security related operations
- Ability to communicate effectively in English
