

ICAO Behavior Detection Course

Course Aim

This course is designed to equip participants with knowledge, skills and attitude required to apply behavior detection techniques and methods in order to enhance overall protection against acts of unlawful interference in accordance with ICAO Annex 17 and the Aviation Security Manual (Doc 8973) (Restricted) and the state guidance materials.

Who should attend

Security personnel involved in developing, implementing, supervising, or overseeing aviation security measures, including:

- Civil aviation authority aviation security personnel;
- Staff from regulatory bodies, law enforcement, airports, airlines, and service providers involved in aviation and airport security; and
- Aviation security instructors responsible for delivering this or related training.

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age: 18 years
- Must be actively employed in a role where aviation security duties are among the core functions, and the employer must provide formal confirmation of the same
- Minimum of diploma recognized by NACTVET or Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education (ACSEE) OR;
- For the case of non-Tanzanian certificate holders, submission of a nomination form or letter from ICAO, Civil Aviation Authority, Airport Authority, Aircraft Operator or Ground Handling Agent as applicable
- Ability to communicate effectively in English
